Harvest Appeal

God takes the small things and multiplies beyond our imaginations

Five loaves and two fish. This well-known Bible story is remarkable. Jesus used a gift from a small boy to feed 5,000 men and many more women and children. And still, there were leftovers.

This harvest, our Tearfund resource for your church focuses on the incredible truth that God can multiply our gifts. When we give him the small things we hold in our hands, he takes them and uses them for his glory.

Isaac from South Sudan knows this first hand.

'We used to only eat once a day, but now we eat three meals a day.'

When conflict broke out in South Sudan in 2016, Isaac had to leave everything he'd worked so hard to build up and flee with his family to a refugee camp in Uganda.

After four unhappy years, Isaac decided to return home. But the only thing he found was charred remains. Everything he owned had been burnt to the ground.

Isaac faced extreme hardship. Civil war devastated his earning potential, leaving him unable to feed his family.

Poverty is stealing hope and robbing millions of people of their potential.

But we believe in a world where everyone has the chance to thrive and experience a fuller life.





Unleashing hope through church-led poverty solutions

When your church gives to Tearfund it provides the finances for innovative Bible-based training to be delivered through local churches around the world. This training brings hope and belonging through the local church, and communities begin to use their own skills and resources to lift themselves out of poverty.

Tearfund's Transforming Communities programme brings change that is both sustainable and equipping.

As we invest in communities, we can help transform lives because God takes the small things and multiplies them beyond all we can imagine.

Isaac's story

'When I got here (South Sudan), all of my grass-thatched houses had been burnt down,' explains Isaac. 'I didn't know where to go. My only option was to go to the church. Then I was welcomed there.'

The pastor invited Isaac into his home, providing him with temporary accommodation as he joined the Transforming Communities training that Tearfund had introduced at the church.

'The church gave me the courage to forget about the horrors of the past and focus on starting a new chapter,' Isaac continues.

'I learnt that God provided us with resources in creation. Then I began to discover what these resources are. I had an idea to plant trees.' As Isaac's understanding and confidence grew, he developed additional skills and decided to grow new trees which provided more income for his family.

'We used to only eat once a day, but now we eat three meals a day. And the money I get from selling fruit helps to pay for my children to go to school.'

Just like the boy with the five loaves and two fish, Isaac offered God all he held in his hands and God multiplied it for his glory.



Partner with purpose and tackle poverty together

Isaac ends his story with a heartfelt plea. 'I'd like to encourage them (Tearfund) to provide the training to more people. I don't want it to end with me.'

We don't want the training to end with Isaac either. When we invest in church-led training, faith is strengthened, churches grow and communities begin to thrive as people realise their God-given potential.

We are already working with 32,000 churches in some of the poorest areas of the world, but we have an incredible vision to see 250,000 churches trained up through our Transforming Communities programme.

In the weeks leading up to your harvest service, let your congregation know that this harvest they'll be hearing about Isaac from South Sudan.

You can put website links up on the screen for people to look up during the service or copy them down to take home and look up later.



Welcome

To add to your usual warm welcome, you could mention that the theme of the harvest service is around how God can multiply our gifts.

An interactive, icebreaker game can be a great way to start a service, especially with children in the congregation.

Before the service, print out the five loaves and two fish cut-outs. Attach them under seats around the church. After the welcome, invite the children to search for the paper clues. As they bring them up to the front, ask the children if they know what story in the Bible these pictures represent.

Read out the Bible passage Mark **6:30-44** – Jesus feeds the five thousand.



Appeal slides

These slides will guide you through Isaac's story, providing all the background info you need on Tearfund's harvest appeal. You can show these in your service and talk through them, or allow people to read through them in their own time.

These additional readings can be used at any point during your service.
